

The 2016 ICMEMO Conference was part of the ICOM Milan Triennial Assembly in July. Over 100 participants and speakers from six continents joined ICMEMO sessions. They came from Chile, Kazakhstan, Cambodia, Mexico, Japan, China, Argentina, Ukraine, Ecuador, Russia... Sessions were held in partnership with the University of Exeter, ICOMAM -IC for Museums of Arms & Military History, AHRC-LABEX, EUROM - European Observatory on Memories, IMSLI... and included topics such as Post-Soviet and South American Dictatorships and Dark Tourism; with trips to Modena, Carpi, Fossoli and Turin.

2016 TASK FORCE TO VILNIUS

A Special Advisory Committee of seven Board Members and past ICMEMO Chairs traveled to Vilnius, Lithuania in October to advise our member institution Vilna Gaon State Jewish Museum. Working together with Museum staff, the Committee met with Ministers, Parliament members, the President of the Jewish Community, toured historic sites, and recommended an action protocol.
