Instructions for the abstract/proposal's submission

All Abstracts should be sent in **English**, attached as a **separate Word Document** (.doc or .docx file) and consists of (in case of joint participation, required information from 1 to point 6 refers to each author):

1. **Name, surname**
2. **Affiliation**
3. **Country, city, E-mail address, phone number,**
4. **ICOM membership number and committee** (ICOM membership is not mandatory)
5. **Short bio** (max. 200 words)
6. **The format of participation**
7. **The ways of participation:**
 - a) Oral Speech / Paper Presentation (on-site, max. 15 minutes)
 - b) Highlight Session - Ignite Talks (on-site, 5 minutes to talk accompanied by 20 slides, 15 seconds each).
 - c) Digital Poster (online)
 - d) Short Video (online)
8. **Title of contribution**
9. **Sub-Theme** (please choose 1 from suggested 3 sub-themes)
10. **Abstract** - do not exceed 300 words / no images nor bibliography (**applies to all ways of participation**)
11. **3-5 Keywords**
12. Technical requirements for the proposed presentation

Special Instructions for the Digital Posters and Short Videos

In case of participating with a Poster or Short Video, after approvement of the abstract/proposal, to get the final approvement from the Conference scientific committee, applicants will be asked to send a **draft visual version** of:

- **Posters** - static image (jpg, landscape format)
- **Short Videos** – MP4 format, 8 to 10 minutes presentation.

** Important notes:*

- a) All submitted images and video material must either be original works created by the author or have been licensed under a Creative Commons or similar agreement.
- b) If video file size reduction is impossible to send by email, please consider sending it through file-sharing platforms such as WeTransfer or similar.
